1. Course Structure:

- Lecture Week: starts on a Friday. So week 0 is just last Wednesday and today. Assignments are released every Wednesday and the deadline is in one week on Tuesday at 23:59.
- Assignments: Two types, written assignments that you can find on the website and quizzes on Moodle.
- Hand-In: You can upload your solution for the first question in each week's assignment on Moodle. I see your solution and give you feedback. To receive feedback you must upload your solution in one week following the release of the assignment.
- *Bonus Points:* You receive bonus points for bonus-quizzes on Moodle and for some written tasks. The result of the 10 best bonus questions along the semester can win you +0.25 points for your final grade. You get 3 tries for each bonus-quiz on Moodle and the deadline is at the end of the current lecture week. The bonus-quizzes are auto-graded, but you have to hand in the written bonus questions to receive points.

- Moodle: Any updates, announcements, forums to ask questions, hand-in page for written assignments, bonus quizzes, weekly voluntary quizzes
